Beyond his legal practice, Majekodunmi is passionate about advancing diversity and inclusion in the legal profession in Europe. He founded the Foreign-Trained Lawyers Network, a social enterprise dedicated to amplifying the skills of internationally qualified lawyers and supporting their integration into new jurisdictions across Europe. Through networking events, mentoring opportunities, and collaborative initiatives, he fosters connections between internationally trained and locally trained lawyers, building an inclusive and diverse legal workforce.



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ROBERT MICHELS

Robert Michels is a leading voice in capital markets law and financial innovation, bringing over two decades of experience at the intersection of traditional securities practice and emerging technology. As Partner at Dentons, he advises listed companies on compliance and post listing obligations, guides issuers through complex structured product offerings, and has become one of Germany's most recognized authorities on Blockchain, Distributed Ledger Technology, and the tokenization of securities and digital assets.

Awet Tesfaiesus is a Member of the German Bundestag representing Werra-Meißner-Hersfeld-Rotenburg in Hesse, where she serves on the Committee on Legal Affairs (Rechtsausschuss) and as spokesperson for Culture and Media for the Green Bundestag group. Born in Asmara, Eritrea, she came to Germany with her family as a child and grew up near Heidelberg. She studied law at Heidelberg University, qualified as a Rechtsanwältin in 2006, and spent the following fifteen years running her own practice in Kassel focused on asylum and social law before entering the Bundestag in 2021 as the first Black woman ever elected to the body.

Her path building a legal career in Germany from the ground up and now helping shape legislation from within the Rechtsausschuss gives her a distinctive vantage point on migration, integration, and access to the legal profession. It makes her a compelling voice for FTLG's conversation on policy reform toward recognition of foreign legal qualifications and on the broader question of how Germany positions its legal system to attract and retain international talent, keeping it competitive as a jurisdiction and legal market on the world stage.



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CASPER LAURSEN

Casper Laursen is the co-founder and CEO of Pandektes Raised across Denmark and Germany, with stints in London and China, he brings a distinctly international perspective to building European legal technology. Having spoken with more than 1,000 legal professionals across Europe, Casper has developed a deep understanding of how technology is reshaping legal research and the wider legal industry

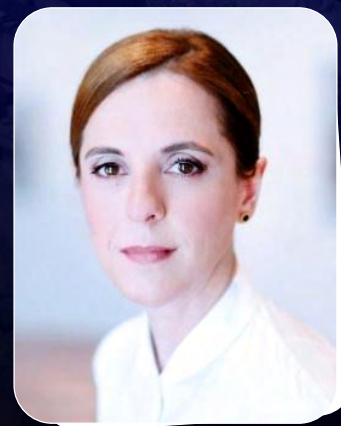
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DR. JONELA HOXHAI
